The Committee on Commerce and Consumer Services (Klein)  
recommended the following **substitute for amendment** (551560):

**Senate Amendment**

On page 7, line 27, through page 8, line 7, delete  
those lines

and insert:

(5) Pursuant to s. 212.099, a retail dealer of motor  
fuel that chooses to participate in the Florida Disaster Motor  
Fuel Supplier Program may receive a sales tax credit of up to  
25 percent of the value of the cost to install appropriate  
wiring and transfer switches required to meet certification  
requirements established by the Division of Emergency  
Management or by the director of the county emergency  
management agency. The total tax credit for a single certified  
location may not exceed \$2,000.

(6) In addition, a retail dealer of motor fuel that  
chooses to participate in the Florida Disaster Motor Fuel  
Supplier Program may receive a sales tax credit of up to 25  
percent of the value of the purchase of a generator,
