(2) The Criminal Justice Standards and Training 30 Commission shall establish standards for instructing law

12	(4) After completing the basic-skills course, each law

14	must complete a training course on the use of dart-firing stun
15	guns. The training course on the use of stun guns must be a
16	minimum of 4 hours' duration every 2 years.

21	SENATE SUMMARY
22	Limits the use of dart-firing stun guns by certain law enforcement officers. Requires the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission to establish training standards for using dart-firing stun guns. Requires continuing education for law enforcement, correctional, and correctional probation officers.
