(740456):

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 3, line 8, delete that line

and insert: Statutes, until July 1, 2008, and after approval
by a majority vote of the electors of the state voting in a
referendum in the next general election. After certification,
the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall
submit a statement that includes a brief and general
description of the purposes to be funded, conforming to the
requirements of s. 101.161(1), to the Department of State to
be reviewed and placed upon the ballot by the supervisors of
elections. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic
Development must publish notice of the referendum once in the
tenth week, and once in the sixth week immediately preceding
the week in which the election is held, in one newspaper of
general circulation in each county in which a newspaper is
published. Any costs associated with the required referendum
must be borne by the applicant.
