(172868):

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 13, between lines 21 and 22,

insert:

Section 7. In order to be certified as a retained professional sports franchise by the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development as provided by this act, the professional basketball franchise located in Orlando must establish a 30-year program to provide paid summer internships to qualified youth in the Professional Opportunities Program for students in Orange County. The amount that is paid to participants in the intern program must initially be at least \$500,000. The internship shall be open to young people who are 16 through 18 years of age and who are of Haitian, Puerto Rican, or African-American descent.
