Senator Siplin moved the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 38 and 29,

insert:

Section 2. In order to be certified as a retained professional sports franchise by the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development as provided by this act, the professional basketball franchise located in Orlando must establish a 30-year program to provide paid summer internships to qualified youth in this state. The amount that is paid to participants in the intern program must initially be at least \$500. The internship shall be open to young people who are 16 through 18 years of age and who are of Haitian, Puerto Rican, or African-American descent.
