On page 16, between lines 4 and 5,

insert:

Section 17. Notwithstanding the passage of House Bill 7239 or other similar legislation during the 2006 Regular Session, a charter county that enacted, on or before January 1, 2000, a local ordinance that regulates refunds by retail establishments may continue to enforce its local ordinance and is not preempted by the provisions of s. 501.142, Florida Statutes, or any rules adopted thereunder by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
