12 systems within the Wekiva Study Area. The objectives of the
13 study shall be determined by the department's technical review
14 and advisory panel, which shall also oversee the study. The
15 report shall assess whether onsite sewage treatment and disposal
16 systems are a significant source of nitrogen to the underlying
17 ground water relative to other sources and shall recommend a

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18 range of possible cost-effective onsite sewage treatment and
19 disposal system nitrogen reduction strategies if contributions
20 are significant. Rulemaking under section 369.318(2), Florida
21 Statutes, shall be suspended until the completion of the study.
22 The Department of Health shall submit a report to the Governor,
23 the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of
24 Representatives no later than February 1, 2007.
