Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 8, between lines 19 and 20,

insert:

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 106.022, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

106.022 Appointment of a registered agent; duties.--

(1) Each political committee, committee of continuous existence, or electioneering communications organization ~~entity~~ shall have and continuously maintain in this state a registered office and a registered agent and must file with the division a statement of appointment for the registered office and registered agent. The statement of appointment must:

(a) Provide the name of the registered agent and the street address and phone number for the registered office;

(b) Identify the entity for whom the registered agent serves;

1 (c) Designate the address the registered agent wishes
2 to use to receive mail;

3 (d) Include the entity's undertaking to inform the
4 division of any change in such designated address;

5 (e) Provide for the registered agent's acceptance of

7 is familiar with and accepts the obligations of the position
8 as set forth in this section; and

9 (f) Contain the signature of the registered agent and
10 the entity engaging the registered agent.
