12 violates any provision of this section commits:

13 (a) A misdemeanor of the second degree for a first
14 violation, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

15 (b) A misdemeanor of the first degree for a second
16 violation, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

17 (c) A felony of the third degree for a third or subsequent
18 violation, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or
19 s. 775.084.

20 (5) A person who violates any provision of this section
21 within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising a child care
22 facility as defined in s. 402.302 that is in compliance with the
23 signage requirements for child care facilities in s.
24 893.13(1)(c); a public or private elementary, middle, or
25 secondary school; or a physical place for worship where a church
26 or religious organization regularly conducts religious services;
27 or in, on, or within 1,000 feet of real property comprising a
28 state, county, or municipal park, a community center, or a
29 publicly owned recreational facility, the penalty shall be
30 reclassified as follows:

31 1. A misdemeanor of the second degree is reclassified to a
32 misdemeanor of the first degree.

33 2. A misdemeanor of the first degree is reclassified to a
34 felony of the third degree.

36 felony of the second degree.
