(11) (a) Any filing required to be submitted to the office by a property insurer under this section or under s. 624.413, s. 627.062(2)(b), or s. 624.448 shall include a statement of certification signed under oath by the chief executive officer and the chief financial officer of the insurer certifying that the business and financial data provided in conjunction with such filing fairly represents in all material respects the true and accurate financial condition of the insurer's business operations. The office shall disregard and return, without prejudice for refiling, any filing made by an insurer that does

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18 not include the sworn statements of certification required by

(b) A person signing a statement of certification as required by this subsection in conjunction with the submission of a filing known by such person to materially misrepresent the business or financial condition of the insurer constitutes a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s.

Willfully falsifying any business or financial data of an insurer with the intent of materially misrepresenting an insurer's business or financial condition in any filing subject to the statement of certification requirement of this subsection constitutes a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in s.
