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The Committee on Judiciary (Baker) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 6, between lines 5 and 6,

insert:

Section 3. Paragraph (h) is added to subsection (1) of section 382.013, Florida Statutes, to read:

382.013 Birth registration.--A certificate for each live birth that occurs in this state shall be filed within 5 days after such birth with the local registrar of the district in which the birth occurred and shall be registered by the local registrar if the certificate has been completed and filed in accordance with this chapter and adopted rules. The information regarding registered births shall be used for comparison with information in the state case registry, as defined in chapter 61.

(1) FILING.--

(h) The local registrar may receive electronically a birth certificate for each live birth which is required to be

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1 filed with the registrar under this chapter through facsimile
 2 or other electronic transfer for the purpose of filing the
 3 birth certificate. The receipt of a birth certificate by
 4 electronic transfer constitutes delivery to the local
 5 registrar as required by law.

14 information; requiring the department to adopt
15 rules; amending s. 382.013, F.S.; authorizing
16 the local registrar of the Office of Vital
17 Statistics of the Department of Health to
18 receive electronically the birth certificate
19 for each live birth that is required to be
