recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment

On page 2, lines 4-6, delete those lines

and insert: Regulation determines that:

a. insureds who intend to travel are a separate
actuarially supportable class whose risk of loss is different
from those insureds who do not intend to travel; or

b. the decision is based on sound actuarial principles
and actual or reasonably anticipated experience that
correlates to the risk of travel to a specific destination.
