Eligible grants shall be in an amount of up to 50 percent of the cost of the 18 water heater and shall not exceed \$500. The program may match up 19 20 to one-half the amount of each eligible grant. LOW-INTEREST LOAN PROGRAM. -- The Department of 21 (2) 22 Community Affairs shall develop a low-interest loan program for residential and business consumers who purchase solar panels for 23 24 electricity generation. The interest rate and term for the loans 25 shall be set by the department, with a maximum interest rate of 26 2 percent below the average 30-year home mortgage interest rate 27 and a term not to exceed 30 years.
