(b) Students may purchase a class ring from any vendor. (c) Vendors may not discriminate against a student who 27 purchases a class ring from another vendor or exclude the 28 student from participation in any ceremony or activity relating 29 to the receipt of a class ring. 30

(6) (a) If entering into a contract with a photographer for 31 32 the purpose of taking student photographs, request proposals from at least two photographers annually. Results of proposals, 33 including vendor contact information, shall be open to the 34 public and posted on the district school board's website. 35

(b) District school boards may not require students to 36 purchase senior photographs from a contract vendor and must 37 allow students to purchase photographs from a photographer of 38 39 their choice. A student's senior photograph must be allowed to appear in the yearbook when taken by a photographer not under 40 41 contract with the district school board if the photograph meets 42 the reasonable specifications of the principal and yearbook staff for senior photographs. 43
