13	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

15	Section 1. Present subsection (3) of section 316.085,
16	Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (5), and new
17	subsections (3) and (4) are added to that section, to read:
18	316.085 Limitations on overtaking, passing, changing
19	lanes and changing course
20	(3) A motor vehicle may not be driven outside of the
21	<u>authorized lane of travel or over, across, or within a</u>
22	pavement marking or traffic control device for the purpose of
23	overtaking or passing another vehicle except where the
24	pavement marking or traffic control device explicitly permits
25	such overtaking or passing. This prohibition does not apply to
26	maneuvers taken to avoid disabled vehicles or obstructions.
27	(4) A motor vehicle may not be driven from a direct
28	course in a lane on a highway until the driver has determined
29	that the vehicle is not entering a vehicular queue at a point
30	ahead of the last vehicle in the queue. As used in this
31	subsection, the term "queue" means more than one vehicle

proceeding in the same direction, traveling at less than the posted speed limit, and aligned in one or more lanes for the purpose of exiting or entering a roadway, merging, or traveling through a designated construction zone. (5) (3) A violation of this section is a noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a moving violation as provided in chapter 318. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006. SENATE SUMMARY Prohibits driving outside of certain authorized lanes or within pavement markings or traffic control devices except where explicitly permitted. Prohibits a vehicle from entering a queue of slow-moving traffic ahead of the last vehicle. 2.4
