competency acquired through an organized sequence of formal education, training, experience, and professional standing.

- (2) A person licensed as a psychologist or school psychologist may not hold himself or herself out as a certified psychology specialist or psychology diplomate unless the person has received formal recognition as a board-certified psychology specialist or psychology diplomate from a recognized certifying body that has been approved by the board.
- (3) The board shall adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 to establish criteria for approval of certifying bodies pursuant to the requirements of subsection (2). The criteria shall include:
  - (a) Peer review and self study.
  - (b) Established standards.

- (c) Assessments of competencies characteristic of the specialty.
  - (d) Administrative support.
- (e) A unified relationship to the public and the profession.
- (4) A person licensed under this chapter may indicate the services he or she offers and may indicate that his or her practice is limited to one or more types of services when this accurately reflects his or her scope of practice.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
