**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 1, line 23,

insert:

Section 1. Any agency, as defined in s. 119.011,  
Florida Statutes, or legislative entity that operates a  
website and uses electronic mail shall post the following  
statement in a conspicuous location on its website:

E-mail addresses are public records under  
Florida Law and are not exempt from  
public-records requirements. If you do not want  
your e-mail address to be subject to being  
released pursuant to a public-records request  
do not send electronic mail to this entity.  
Instead, contact this office by telephone or in  
writing, via the United States Postal Service.
