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CS Section 1. Obtaining telephone calling records by 23 24 fraudulent means prohibited. --(1) As used in this section, the term: 25 26 (a) "Calling record" means a record held by a 27 telecommunications company of the telephone calls made or text messages sent or received by a customer of that company. 28 "Customer" means a person who has received telephone 29 (b) 30 service from a telecommunications company. (c) "Law enforcement agency" has the same meaning as in s. 31 32 23.1225(1)(d), Florida Statutes. "Telecommunications company" has the same meaning as 33 (d) in s. 364.02, Florida Statutes, except that the term includes 34 35 VoIP service and commercial mobile radio service providers. 36 It is a violation of this section for a person to: (2) (a) Obtain or attempt to obtain the calling record of 37 another person without the permission of that person by: 38 1. Making a false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or 39 40 representation to an officer, employee, or agent of a telecommunications company; 41 Making a false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or 42 2. representation to a customer of a telecommunications company; or 43 44 3. Providing any document to an officer, employee, or agent of a telecommunications company, knowing that the document 45 is forged, is counterfeit, was lost or stolen, was fraudulently 46 47 obtained, or contains a false, fictitious, or fraudulent 48 statement or representation. 49 Ask another person to obtain a calling record, knowing (b) 50 that the other person will obtain, or attempt to obtain, the Page 2 of 3

Sell or offer to sell a calling record obtained in any 53 (C) 54 manner described in paragraph (a) or paragraph (b). 55 A person who violates this section for the first time (3) 56 commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, Florida Statutes. A second 57 or subsequent violation constitutes a felony of the third 58 59 degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, 60 Florida Statutes. 61 It is not a violation of this section for: (4) 62 (a) A law enforcement agency to obtain a calling record in 63 connection with the performance of the official duties of that agency in accordance with other applicable laws. 64 (b) A telecommunications company, or an officer, employee, 65 or agent of a telecommunications company, to obtain a calling 66 67 record of that company in the course of: 1. Testing the security procedures or systems of the 68 69 telecommunications company for maintaining the confidentiality 70 of customer information; Investigating an allegation of misconduct or negligence 71 2. 72 on the part of an officer, employee, or agent of the telecommunications company; or 73 74 3. Recovering a calling record that was obtained or 75 received by another person in any manner described in subsection 76 (2). 77 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.

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
