22 1006.28 Duties of district school board, district school 23 superintendent; and school principal regarding K-12 24 instructional materials.--

25 (1)DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD. -- The district school board has the duty to provide adequate instructional materials for all 26 27 students in accordance with the requirements of this part. The term "adequate instructional materials" means a sufficient 28 29 number of textbooks or sets of materials serving as the basis for instruction for each student in the core courses of 30 mathematics, language arts, social studies, science, reading, 31 32 and literature, except for instruction for which the school advisory council approves the use of a program that does not 33 34 include a textbook as a major tool of instruction. The district 35 school board has the following specific duties:

(b) Textbooks.--

Provide for proper requisitioning, distribution, 37 1. accounting, storage, care, and use of all instructional 38 materials furnished by the state and furnish such other 39 40 instructional materials as may be needed. The district school board shall assure that instructional materials used in the 41 42 district are consistent with the district goals and objectives 43 and the curriculum frameworks adopted by rule of the State Board of Education, as well as with the state and district performance 44 standards provided for in s. 1001.03(1). 45

2. During the first 2 years of the adoption cycle,
beginning with the 2006-2007 school year, purchase sufficient
textbooks to provide a classroom set of textbooks for use in
each core curriculum classroom in grades 6 through 8. The
