4	of Lauderhill to include specific unincorporated lands
5	within said corporate limits; providing an effective date.

7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
8	
9	Section 1. The present corporate limits of the City of
10	Lauderhill, Broward County, are hereby extended and enlarged so
11	as to include, in addition to the territory presently within its
12	corporate limits, the area consisting of a portion of Sunrise
13	Boulevard, particularly described as follows:

15	That portion of Sunrise Boulevard in Section 31,
16	Township 49 South, Range 42 East, Broward County,
17	Florida, described as follows:

All rights, title, interests, and 231 232 responsibilities for those Broward County transferred roads, including, but not limited to, the ownership, operation, 233 maintenance, planning, design, and construction of said roads 234 235 and the rights-of-way associated therewith, shall transfer from 236 Broward County jurisdiction and ownership to the jurisdiction 237 and ownership of the annexing municipality upon the effective 238 date of the annexation. 239 Section 6. On the effective date of this act, the City of 240 Lauderhill shall be responsible for and embodied with all municipal powers granted in chapter 166, Florida Statutes, 241 242 including, but not limited to, police powers, over territory 243 hereby annexed. Section 7. Nothing in this act shall be construed to 244 245 affect or abrogate the rights of parties to any contracts, or between nongovernmental entities, which contracts are in effect 246 247 prior to the effective date of the annexation. 248 Section 8. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
