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24 program shall encourage collaboration with local mental health 25 facilities and individual professionals. (2) During the 2006-2007 fiscal year, an SOS pilot program 26 27 shall be conducted in Brevard, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties. In order to receive funding under this act, an SOS 28 29 entity for a county authorized to participate in the pilot program must submit to the Department of Education by September 30 1, 2006, a proposal for suicide and depression prevention for 31 secondary school students who attend school in that county. The 32 pilot program shall provide school personnel in each 33 participating school with the materials necessary for 34 35 implementation. 36 The parent of each student in a participating school (3) shall be provided with a copy of program information and a 37 38 screening form to assist the parent in the identification of depression and suicidal tendencies and to help initiate family 39 40 discussions. (4) By January 1, 2007, the district school board of each 41 42 participating county shall provide to the President of the 43 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a report that includes an itemized list of program costs, an evaluation 44 45 of participating schools, an assessment of the quality of the program components, an assessment of the safety of program 46 implementation, an assessment of the burden on school support 47 staff after implementation of the program, an assessment of the 48 49 efficacy of the program, and recommendations regarding program 50 effects and outcomes. The information shall be reported for the

| 53 | Section 2. The sum of \$600,000 is appropriated from the        |
| 54 | General Revenue Fund to the Department of Education for the     |

| 56 | Foundation to implement the Signs of Suicide Prevention Program |
| 57 | as a pilot program for secondary schools in Brevard, Orange,    |
