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CS 24 Signs of Suicide Prevention Program for secondary schools, 25 hereinafter referred to as "SOS." The pilot program shall encourage collaboration with local mental health facilities and 26 27 individual professionals. (2) During the 2006-2007 fiscal year, an SOS pilot program 28 shall be conducted in Brevard, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole 29 counties. In order to receive funding under this act, an SOS 30 31 entity for a county authorized to participate in the pilot 32 program must submit to the Department of Education by September 1, 2006, a proposal for suicide and depression prevention for 33 34 secondary school students who attend school in that county. The 35 pilot program shall provide school personnel in each 36 participating school with the materials necessary for 37 implementation. 38 (3) The parent or legal guardian of each student in a 39 participating school shall be provided with a copy of program 40 information and a screening form to assist the parent or legal quardian in the identification of depression and suicidal 41 42 tendencies and to help initiate family discussions. There shall be no screening of students without the written consent of a 43 parent or legal guardian. 44 45 (4) By January 1, 2007, the district school board of each 46 participating county shall provide to the President of the 47 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a report that includes an itemized list of program costs, an evaluation 48

49 of participating schools, an assessment of the quality of the

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52 staff after implementation of the program, an assessment of the efficacy of the program, and recommendations regarding program 53 effects and outcomes. The information shall be reported for the 54 55 pilot program in the aggregate, for each participating county, and for each participating school in each participating county. 56 57 Section 2. Implementation of the pilot program conducted by the Signs of Suicide Prevention Program for secondary schools 58 59 shall be contingent upon funding in the 2006-2007 General Appropriations Act. Funds appropriated to the Department of 60 Education for the pilot program shall be distributed to the 61 62 Michael Buonauro Foundation to implement the pilot program in 63 accordance with this act. In order to receive state funds for 64 this purpose, the Michael Buonauro Foundation shall provide 65 matching funds in an amount equal to the appropriation. 66 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.

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
