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A bill to be entitled

An act relating to suicide prevention; providing for a pilot program to be conducted by the Signs of Suicide Prevention Program for secondary schools in specified counties; requiring the submission of proposals to the Department of Education; providing for student participation in the pilot program and for the provision of certain information to parents and legal guardians; requiring a report to the Legislature; requiring implementation of the pilot program to be contingent upon state funding and equivalent matching funds; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Signs of Suicide Prevention Program for secondary schools; pilot program.--
- (1) Contingent upon funding in the General Appropriations

 Act, there is established a pilot program to be conducted by the

 Signs of Suicide Prevention Program for secondary schools,

 hereinafter referred to as "SOS." The pilot program shall

 encourage collaboration with local mental health facilities and

 individual professionals.
- (2) During the 2006-2007 fiscal year, an SOS pilot program shall be conducted in Brevard, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties. In order to receive funding under this act, an SOS entity for a county authorized to participate in the pilot

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program must submit to the Department of Education by September 1, 2006, a proposal for suicide and depression prevention for secondary school students who attend school in that county. The pilot program shall provide school personnel in each participating school with the materials necessary for implementation.

- (3) The parent or legal guardian of each student in a participating school shall be provided with a copy of program information and a screening form to assist the parent or legal guardian in the identification of depression and suicidal tendencies and to help initiate family discussions. There shall be no screening of students without the written consent of a parent or legal guardian.
- (4) By January 1, 2007, the district school board of each participating county shall provide to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a report that includes an itemized list of program costs, an evaluation of participating schools, an assessment of the quality of the program components, an assessment of the safety of program implementation, an assessment of the burden on school support staff after implementation of the program, an assessment of the efficacy of the program, and recommendations regarding program effects and outcomes. The information shall be reported for the pilot program in the aggregate, for each participating county, and for each participating school in each participating county.

 Section 2. Implementation of the pilot program conducted

by the Signs of Suicide Prevention Program for secondary schools

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Appropriations Act. Funds appropriated to the Department of Education for the pilot program shall be distributed to the Michael Buonauro Foundation to implement the pilot program in accordance with this act. In order to receive state funds for this purpose, the Michael Buonauro Foundation shall provide matching funds in an amount equal to the appropriation.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.

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
