27	commences on March 2 of the year in which the appointment is

the term or may continue until a successor is appointed, but not more than 180 days. Terms of office of governing board members shall be staggered to help maintain consistency and continuity in the exercise of governing board duties and to minimize disruption in district operations.

Membership on governing boards shall be selected from 34 (2) 35 candidates who have significant experience in one or more of the following areas, including, but not limited to: agriculture, the 36 development industry, local government, government-owned or 37 privately owned water utilities, law, civil engineering, 38 environmental science, hydrology, accounting, or financial 39 businesses.
