1 Section 1. Section 215.5605, Florida Statutes, is 2 created to read: 3 215.5605 Florida Prepaid Tuition Scholarship 4 Endowment. --5 (1) FLORIDA PREPAID TUITION SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT; 6 CREATION; PRINCIPAL.--7 (a) There is created the Florida Prepaid Tuition Scholarship Endowment, to be administered by the State Board 8 of Administration. The purpose of the endowment is to provide 9 10 a perpetual source of enhanced funding for the Florida Prepaid Tuition Scholarship Program to provide prepaid postsecondary 11 12 tuition scholarships for economically disadvantaged youth. The 13 endowment shall be exempt from the service charges imposed by <u>s. 215.20.</u> 14 (b) The endowment shall receive moneys from the tax on 15 slot machine revenues as defined in s. 551.106. Moneys to be 16 17 transferred from the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund to the Florida Prepaid Tuition Scholarship Endowment shall be in the 18 amount provided by the Legislature in the General 19 Appropriations Act to the Department of Education. The 2.0 21 department shall transfer the appropriated funds to the 2.2 endowment at the State Board of Administration. 23 (c) The principal in the endowment shall be reserved and accounted for within the endowment and the earnings shall 2.4 be used, as appropriated by the Legislature, for the funding 25 of Florida Prepaid Tuition Scholarships for economically 26 27 disadvantaged youth as provided in s. 1009.984. 2.8 (2) DEFINITIONS.--As used in this section, the term: (a) "Board" means the State Board of Administration 29 30 established by s. 16, Art. IX of the State Constitution of 31

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1 1885 and incorporated into s. 9(c), Art. XII of the State Constitution of 1968. 2 (b) "Endowment" means the Florida Prepaid Tuition 3 4 Scholarship Endowment. 5 (c) "Earnings" means all income generated by б investments. 7 (d) "Department" means the Department of Education. 8 (3) ADMINISTRATION.--9 (a) The board may invest and reinvest funds of the 10 endowment in accordance with s. 215.47 and consistent with a trust agreement as provided in s. 215.44. 11 12 (b) In accordance with s. 215.44, the board shall 13 include separate sections on the financial status of the endowment in its annual investment report to the Legislature. 14 (c) The board shall report to the Legislature by 15 February 1 each year the estimated amount of earnings in the 16 17 endowment as of June 30 of that year. The Legislature may or 18 may not appropriate the available earnings in any fiscal year for Florida Prepaid Tuition Scholarships as provided in s. 19 1009.984. The board shall transfer earnings to the Educational 2.0 21 Enhancement Trust Fund in the amount appropriated by the 2.2 Legislature. 23 (d) Accountability for funds from the endowment which have been appropriated to the Department of Education and 2.4 distributed by the board shall reside with the department. The 25 board is not responsible or accountable for the proper 26 27 expenditure of funds from the endowment after distribution to 2.8 the department. (e) Costs and fees of the board for investment 29 30 services shall be deducted from the earnings accruing to the 31

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1	endowment. Fees for investment services shall be no greater
2	than fees charged to the Florida Retirement System.
3	(4) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS; USES
4	(a) Earnings in the Florida Prepaid Tuition Endowment
5	Fund shall be transferred by the board to the Educational
б	Enhancement Trust Fund in the amount appropriated from the
7	Educational Enhancement Trust Fund for Florida Prepaid Tuition
8	Scholarships, as provided in s. 1009.984, by the Legislature.
9	(b) In order to ensure that the expenditure of funds
10	earned from the Florida Prepaid Tuition Endowment Fund will be
11	used only for the purposes intended by the Legislature, the
12	Legislature shall establish line item categories that
13	designate the use of the appropriated funds in the General
14	Appropriations Act.
15	(c) Subject to legislative appropriations, the Florida
16	Prepaid College Board shall use distributions from the
17	endowment to provide prepaid postsecondary tuition
18	scholarships to economically disadvantaged youth pursuant to
19	<u>s. 1009.984.</u>
20	(d) Appropriations of endowment investment revenues by
21	the Legislature to the department shall be deposited into the
22	account of the direct-support organization of the Florida
23	Prepaid College Board established pursuant s. 1009.983.
24	(e) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s.
25	216.351, all unencumbered balances of appropriations to the
26	<u>department as of June 30 or undisbursed balances as of</u>
27	September 30 shall revert to the endowment's principal at the
28	board.

5	The bill creates the Florida Prepaid Tuition Scholarship
Endowment within the State Board of Administration for t 6 purpose of providing a perpetual source of enhanced fund	purpose of providing a perpetual source of enhanced funding to
7	provide postsecondary education prepaid tuition scholarships for economically disadvantaged youth. The endowment will receive money, subject to appropriation, from the tax on slot machine revenues. Funds for the endowment will be in an amoun determined annually by the Legislature in the General Appropriations Act.
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10	Administration in the amount appropriated by the Legislature 1 to fund scholarships. Subject to legislative appropriations,
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12	the Florida Prepaid College Board shall use the distributions from the endowment to provide prepaid postsecondary tuition
13	scholarships to economically disadvantaged youth.
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
