5 Section 4. Notwithstanding any other provision in this
6 act, in order to qualify for funds distributed, the Office of
7 Tourism and Economic Development must determine that the
8 applicant has a history of financial investment in its
9 community. In order to remain annually eligible, the Office of
10 Tourism and Economic Development must also determine on an
11 annual basis that financial investment continues. As used in
12 this paragraph, the term "financial investment" shall be defined
13 as having made donations equal to a minimum of 80 percent of
14 each annual distribution:
