A bill to be entitled

An act relating to regulation of smoking; amending s. 386.209, F.S.; authorizing municipalities and counties to regulate smoking at public outdoor athletic facilities under certain circumstances; providing a definition; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 386.209, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

386.209 Regulation of smoking preempted to state.--This part expressly preempts regulation of smoking to the state and supersedes any municipal or county ordinance on the subject, with the exception of a municipal or county ordinance that regulates smoking within 100 feet of a public outdoor athletic facility while persons under the age of 18 are present. For the purposes of this section, "outdoor athletic facility" means an outdoor basketball court, volleyball court, tennis court, racquetball court, badminton court, baseball field, softball field, soccer field, skate park, or similar facility and any portion thereof, including sidelines, dugouts, bleachers or other spectator areas, restroom structures, and concession or eating areas. "Outdoor athletic facility" includes a freestanding playground, a swimming pool, and all areas adjacent thereto.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
