Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: Subsection (1) of section 775.085, Florida Section 1. Statutes, is amended to read: Evidencing prejudice while committing offense; 775.085 reclassification. --The penalty for any felony or misdemeanor shall be (1) (a) reclassified as provided in this subsection if the commission of such felony or misdemeanor evidences prejudice based on the race, color, ancestry, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, national origin, homeless status, mental or physical disability, or advanced age of the victim: A misdemeanor of the second degree is reclassified to a 1. misdemeanor of the first degree. A misdemeanor of the first degree is reclassified to a 2. felony of the third degree. 3. A felony of the third degree is reclassified to a felony of the second degree. A felony of the second degree is reclassified to a 4. felony of the first degree.
