The Committee on Health Regulation (Peaden) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause

and insert:

Section 1. The Department of Health shall compile data on the frequency and usage of electroconvulsive therapy and psychosurgery procedures on children under 18 years of age in this state. The data shall include the severity of the illness requiring these procedures, any adverse events resulting from the procedures, the efficacy of the procedures, the number of these procedures performed over a 3-year period in this state, the age of the children, and the informed consent process of each procedure. The department shall report this data to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
