13	Section 1. The Department of Health shall compile data
14	concerning the frequency and usage of electroconvulsive
15	therapy and psychosurgery procedures on children under 18
16	years of age in this state. The data shall include the
17	severity of the illness requiring these procedures, any
18	adverse events resulting from the procedures, the efficacy of
19	the procedures, the number of these procedures performed over
20	a 3-year period in this state, the age of the children, and
21	the informed-consent process of each procedure. The department
22	shall report this data to the President of the Senate and the
23	Speaker of the House of Representatives.
24	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

27	COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR <u>Senate Bill 112</u>

29	The committee substitute requires the Department of Health to
30	compile certain data regarding the frequency and usage of electroconvulsive therapy and psychosurgery procedures on children in Electide rather than prohibit the administration of
31	children in Florida rather than prohibit the administration of electroconvulsive therapy and psychosurgery on persons younger than 18 years of age. 1
