29 improvement, or repair of Authority facilities unless the 30 contractor has sufficient surety or sureties, approved by the Authority, and in an amount fixed by the Authority, for the 31 faithful performance of the contract. Any such contract shall 32 include provisions that the person entering into the contract 33 with the Authority will pay for all materials furnished and 34 35 services rendered for the performance of the contract and may 36 maintain an action to recover for the same against the obligor 37 in the undertaking, as though such person was named therein, provided the action is brought within 1 year after the time the 38 cause of action accrued. Nothing in this section shall be 39 construed to limit the power of the Authority to construct, 40 repair, or improve Authority facilities or any addition, 41 betterment, or extension thereto, directly by the officers, 42 43 agents, and employees of the Authority, or otherwise than by 44 contract.

(c) All supplies and materials costing in excess of
\$30,000 \$15,000 shall be purchased only after advertisement. The
Authority shall accept the lowest responsive bid from a
responsible bidder, kind, quality, and material being equal, but
the Authority has the right to reject any or all bids or select
a single item from any bid.
