

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the use or possession of drug paraphernalia; amending s. 893.147, F.S.; providing that the use or possession of drug paraphernalia with intent to undertake certain activities concerning the manufacture or production of methamphetamine is a felony of the second degree; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 893.147, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

893.147 Use, possession, manufacture, delivery, transportation, or advertisement of drug paraphernalia.--

(1) USE OR POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA.--~~A~~ It is unlawful for any person who uses, or possesses to use, or to possess with intent to use, drug paraphernalia:

(a) To plant, propagate, cultivate, grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process, prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, store, contain, or conceal a controlled substance in violation of this chapter commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. ~~or~~

(b) To inject, ingest, inhale, or otherwise introduce into the human body a controlled substance in violation of this chapter commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

(c) To manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process,
