EXEMPTIONS; ACCOUNT OF USE. --17 (5) (e) Gas or electricity used for certain agricultural 18 19 purposes. --Butane gas, propane gas, natural gas, and all other 20 1. 21 forms of liquefied petroleum gases are exempt from the tax 22 imposed by this chapter if used in any tractor, vehicle, or other farm equipment which is used exclusively on a farm or for 23 processing farm products on the farm and no part of which gas is 24 used in any vehicle or equipment driven or operated on the 25 public highways of this state. This restriction does not apply 26 to the movement of farm vehicles or farm equipment between 27 farms. The transporting of bees by water and the operating of 28 Page 1 of 2

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29 equipment used in the apiary of a beekeeper is also deemed an 30 exempt use.

Electricity used directly or indirectly and exclusively 31 2. for production or processing of agricultural products on the 32 farm is exempt from the tax imposed by this chapter. This 33 exemption applies only if the electricity used for the exempt 34 35 purposes is separately metered. If the electricity is not 36 separately metered, it is conclusively presumed that some 37 portion of the electricity is used for a nonexempt purpose, and all of the electricity used for such purposes is taxable. 38 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007. 39

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
