(8) "Auxiliary law enforcement officer" means any person employed or appointed, with or without compensation, who aids or assists a full-time or part-time law enforcement officer and who, while under the direct supervision of a full-time or parttime law enforcement officer, has the authority to arrest and perform law enforcement functions.
