Section 1. Section 1012.225, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1012.225 Merit award program for instructional personnel.--

(1) Subject to appropriation by the Legislature, any funds appropriated for the purposes of this section shall be used for a merit award program plan for all teachers who do not have a negative evaluation to receive annual merit awards to bring their salaries up to the national average salaries, as determined by the United States Department of Education, within 5 years.

- By July 1 2012, the average salary for full-time (b) public school teachers shall be no less than the national average salary for full-time public school teachers.
- The increases in the beginning and the average fulltime public school teacher salaries shall be independent of employee benefits and shall not alter, jeopardize, or decrease existing employee benefits. Payment of the costs associated with increasing beginning and average teacher salaries is the responsibility of the state and not of school districts.
- (2) Nothing in this section shall impair collective bargaining.

Section 2. Proviso language in Specific Appropriation 91 of the 2006-2007 General Appropriations Act, chapter 2006-25, Laws of Florida, and section 3 of chapter 2006-26, Laws of Florida, relating to the Special Teachers Are Rewarded performance pay plan (STAR Plan), are repealed.

Section 3. Effective June 30, 2007, s. 1012.22(1)(c)4., Florida Statutes, is repealed. Rules adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to s. 1012.22, Florida Statutes, which are in conflict with this act are suspended.

Section 4. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
