The law enforcement officer or correctional officer 28 (d) 29 under investigation shall be informed of the nature of the 30 investigation prior to any interrogation, and he or she shall be informed of the names name of all complainants. All identifiable 31 32 witnesses shall be interviewed, whenever possible, prior to the 33 beginning of the investigative interview of the accused officer. The complaint and all witness statements shall be provided to 34 the officer who is the subject of the complaint prior to the 35 beginning of any investigative interview of that officer. 36 37 Section 2.
