| 17 | (a) With respect to a benefit year commencing on or after |
| 18 | October 1, 2007, if an individual is not monetarily eligible in |
| 19 | his or her base period to qualify for benefits, the division |
| 20 | must designate the alternative base period to be his or her base |
| 21 | period. As used in this subsection, the term "alternative base |
| 22 | period" means the last four completed calendar quarters |

A 43 44 determination of benefits based upon an alternative base period 45 shall be adjusted when the quarterly report of wage information 46 is received from the employer if that information causes a 47 change in the determination.
