 2           An act relating to student discipline and school safety;  
 3           amending s. 1006.07, F.S.; revising district school board  
 4           duties relating to emergency management and emergency  
 5           preparedness; providing requirements for the number and  
 6           type of emergency drills conducted by each school;  
 7           providing an effective date.

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9   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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11           Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 1006.07, Florida  
 12   Statutes, is amended to read:

13           1006.07 District school board duties relating to student  
 14   discipline and school safety.--The district school board shall  
 15   provide for the proper accounting for all students, for the  
 16   attendance and control of students at school, and for proper  
 17   attention to health, safety, and other matters relating to the  
 18   welfare of students, including:

19           (4) EMERGENCY DRILLS; EMERGENCY PROCEDURES.--

20           (a) Formulate and prescribe policies and procedures for  
 21   emergency preparation and drill activities ~~drills~~ and for  
 22   response to and management of emergencies, including incidents  
 23   or events resulting from violence, technological malfunction,  
 24   human error, and natural disaster ~~actual emergencies, including,~~  
 25   ~~but not limited to, fires, natural disasters, and bomb threats,~~  
 26   for all the public schools of the district which comprise grades  
 27   K-12. District school board policies must ~~shall~~ include commonly  
 28   used alarm system responses for specific types of emergencies

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29 ~~and verification by each school that drills have been provided~~  
 30 ~~as required by law and fire protection codes.~~ Each school shall  
 31 conduct and document at least 10 emergency drills per school  
 32 year, at least five of which must be emergency egress drills, at  
 33 least one of which must be an accidental or intentional  
 34 hazardous materials release drill, and at least two of which  
 35 must be tornado drills. The focus of the two remaining emergency  
 36 drills shall be at the discretion of each school.

37 (b) The district school board shall establish model  
 38 emergency management and emergency preparedness procedures for  
 39 the following life-threatening emergencies:

40 1. Manmade emergencies, including fires, bomb threats, and  
 41 weapon-use and hostage situations.

42 2. Technological emergencies, including radiological,  
 43 hazardous materials, and ~~or~~ toxic chemical releases ~~spills~~.

44 3. Weather emergencies, including hurricanes, tornadoes,  
 45 and severe storms.

46 ~~4. Exposure as a result of a manmade emergency.~~

47 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
