Authorized games and cardrooms do not constitute casino gaming 2.4 operations. 25 (e) "Cardroom distributor" means any business that 26 27 distributes cardroom paraphernalia such as card tables, 28 betting chips, chip holders, <u>dominoes</u>, <u>dominoes</u> tables, drop boxes, banking supplies, playing cards, card shufflers, and 29 30 other associated equipment to authorized cardrooms. 31

1 (h) "Dominoes" means a game of dominoes typically 2 played with a set of 28 flat rectangular blocks, called bones, 3 which are marked on one side and divided into two equal parts, 4 with zero to six dots, called pips, in each part. The term 5 also includes larger sets of blocks that contain a б correspondingly higher number of pips. The term also means the 7 set of blocks used to play the game. (6) BUSINESS AND EMPLOYEE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE 8 REQUIRED; APPLICATION; FEES.--9 10 (a) A person employed or otherwise working in a cardroom as a cardroom manager, floor supervisor, pit boss, 11 12 dealer, or any other activity related to cardroom operations 13 while the facility is conducting card playing or games of dominoes must hold a valid cardroom employee occupational 14 license issued by the division. Food service, maintenance, and 15 security employees with a current pari-mutuel occupational 16 17 license and a current background check will not be required to 18 have a cardroom employee occupational license.
