43	committee. Local governments that receive the minimum allocation

47 <u>(5) The advisory committee shall be cooperatively staffed</u>
48 <u>by the local government planning and housing departments to</u>

(6) (5) The approval by the advisory committee of its local 51 housing incentive strategies recommendations and its review of 52 53 local government implementation of previously recommended strategies must be made by affirmative vote of a majority of the 54 55 membership of the advisory committee taken at a public hearing. Notice of the time, date, and place of the public hearing of the 56 57 advisory committee to adopt final local housing incentive strategies recommendations must be published in a newspaper of 58 general paid circulation in the county. Such notice must contain 59 a short and concise summary of the local housing incentives 60 strategies recommendations to be considered by the advisory 61 committee. The notice must state the public place where a copy 62 of the tentative advisory committee recommendations can be 63 64 obtained by interested persons.

(7) (7) (6) Within 90 days after the date of receipt of the 65 local housing incentive strategies recommendations from the 66 advisory committee, the governing body of the appointing local 67 government shall adopt an amendment to its local housing 68 69 assistance plan to incorporate the local housing incentive strategies it will implement within its jurisdiction. 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incentive strategies required in s. 420.9071(16).
