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Senator Garcia moved the following **amendment to amendment**

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 15, between lines 20-21,

insert:

Section 6. Subsection (4) is added to section
253.0341, Florida Statutes, to read:

(4) Notwithstanding the requirements of this section
and the requirements of s. 253.034 which provides a surplus
process for the disposal of state lands, the board shall
convey to Miami-Dade County title to the property on which the
Graham Building, which houses the offices of the Miami-Dade
State Attorney, is located. By January 1, 2008, the board
shall convey fee simple title to the property to Miami-Dade
County for a consideration of one dollar. The deed conveying
title to Miami-Dade County must contain restrictions that
limit the use of the property for the purpose of providing
workforce housing as defined in s. 420.5095, and to house the
offices of the Miami-Dade State Attorney. Employees of the

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1 Miami-Dade State Attorney and the Miami-Dade Public Defender
 2 who apply for and meet the income qualifications for workforce
 3 housing shall receive preference over other qualified
 4 applicants.
