Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2), paragraph (a) of subsection (4), paragraph (c) of subsection (7), and paragraph (c) of subsection (12) of section 849.086, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

849.086 Cardrooms authorized.--

- (2) DEFINITIONS.--As used in this section:
- (a)  $\underline{1}$ . "Authorized game" means a game or series of games of poker which are played in a nonbanking manner.
- 2. "Authorized game facilitated by certified electronic gaming equipment" means an authorized game as defined in subparagraph 1. which is played on an electronic poker table that shuffles, deals, pays pots, and otherwise conducts the game 189667

electronically so that players can play the game without a human dealer. The electronic gaming equipment must be certified by a department-approved, independent testing laboratory as providing a mathematically random shuffle and deal process with an equal probability of occurrence for each card.

- (4) AUTHORITY OF DIVISION.--The Division of Pari-mutuel Wagering of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation shall administer this section and regulate the operation of cardrooms under this section and the rules adopted pursuant thereto, and is hereby authorized to:
- (a) Adopt rules, including, but not limited to: the issuance of cardroom and employee licenses for cardroom operations; the operation of a cardroom; procedures for and operation of authorized games facilitated by certified electronic gaming equipment; recordkeeping and reporting requirements; and the collection of all fees and taxes imposed by this section.
  - (7) CONDITIONS FOR OPERATING A CARDROOM. --
- electronic gaming equipment, a cardroom operator must at all times employ and provide a nonplaying dealer for each table on which authorized card games which traditionally utilize a dealer are conducted at the cardroom. Such dealers may not have any participatory interest in any game other than the dealing of cards and may not have an interest in the outcome of the game. The providing of such dealers by a licensee shall not be construed as constituting the conducting of a banking game by the cardroom operator.
