Senate Amendment (with directory and title amendments)

On page 3, between lines 23 and 24,

insert:

(h) The commission shall appoint an executive director and assistant executive director, who shall serve under the direction, supervision, and control of the commission. The executive director, with the consent of the commission, shall employ such staff as are necessary to perform adequately the functions of the commission, within budgetary limitations. All employees of the commission are exempt from part II of chapter 110 and shall serve at the pleasure of the commission. The salaries and benefits of all employees of the commission, except for the executive director, shall be set in accordance with the Selected Exempt Service; ~~provided~~, however, ~~that the~~ salary and benefits of the executive director shall be set in accordance with the Senior Management Service. The commission shall have complete authority for fixing the salary of the
