17	the association, upon filing the lien, must notify the property
18	owner by certified or registered mail.
19	(2) If attorney's fees are assessed against the property
20	owner as a result of the association's efforts to collect the
21	debt that resulted in the lien, the property owner shall pay the
22	attorney's fees before a period of 90 days has expired,
23	including interest at the standard interest rate for such debts.
24	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
