The Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 (Wise) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment

On page 1, lines 22 - 25, delete those lines

and insert: school year, the opening date for schools in the district may not be earlier than 14 days before Labor Day each year. However, a district school board may establish an earlier opening date if the school board meets the following requirements:

- 1. Holds at least three public hearings geographically located throughout the school district;
- 2. Surveys the parents of all enrolled students; and
- 3. Approves the earlier opening date by a supermajority vote.

A school that operates on a year-round or an extended calendar shall open and close pursuant to district school board policy and may have an opening date that is earlier than 14 days before Labor Day.
