A bill to be entitled

An act relating to child care services; providing legislative intent that a child under jurisdiction of the circuit court receive priority consideration for placement into a quality child care center; defining the term "quality child care center"; requiring a quality child care center to immediately notify the legal guardian of a child if the child care center is unable to accept a child into its program due to the center's limited capacity; requiring district child care licensing agencies to provide a report to community-based care lead agencies regarding capacity of quality child care centers; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) It is the intent of the Legislature that a child under the jurisdiction of the circuit court receive priority consideration for placement into a quality child care center pursuant to s. 411.01, Florida Statutes, the School Readiness Act.
- (2) As used in this section, the term "quality child care center" means a child care center that:
- (a) Holds a current Gold Seal Quality Care designation under s. 402.281, Florida Statutes; or
- (b) Has been designated as a high-quality program with at least a quality rating of 3 by a professional quality rating system if such a system exists in the county in which the child

is being served. A quality child care center must maintain accreditation or designation as a high-quality program throughout the year in order to be an approved provider.

- (3) If a quality child care center is unable to accept a child into its program due to the child care center's limited capacity, the center must immediately notify the legal guardian of the child of this fact and the estimated enrollment date for the child.
- (4) The agency in each district that is responsible for licensing child care centers shall provide the community-based care lead agency for the district with a quarterly report of the licensed capacity for each quality child care center in the district.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
