Paragraphs (h) and (i) are added to subsection (14) of section 1.01, Florida Statutes, to read: 14 1.01 Definitions.--In construing these statutes and 15 16 each and every word, phrase, or part hereof, where the context 17 will permit: 18 (14) The term "veteran" means a person who served in the active military, naval, or air service and who was 19 discharged or released therefrom under honorable conditions 20 only or who later received an upgraded discharge under 21 22 honorable conditions, notwithstanding any action by the United 23 States Department of Veterans Affairs on individuals discharged or released with other than honorable discharges. 2.4 To receive benefits as a wartime veteran, a veteran must have 25 26 served in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge 27 has been authorized or a veteran must have served during one 2.8 of the following periods of wartime service: 29 (h) Operation Enduring Freedom: October 7, 2001, and ending on the date thereafter prescribed by presidential 30 31 proclamation or by law.
