The operator must 19 provide proof of ownership pursuant to chapter 317 upon 20 21 request by a law enforcement officer. 22 (2) A county is exempt from this section if the 23 governing body of the county, by majority vote, following a noticed public hearing, votes to exempt the county from this 2.4 section. <u>Alternatively, a county may, by majority vote after</u> 25 such a hearing, designate certain unpaved roadways where an 26 27 ATV may be operated during the daytime so long as each such 2.8 designated roadway has a posted speed limit of less than 35 miles per hour and is appropriately marked to indicate 29 30 permissible ATV use. 31

(3) Any ATV operation that is permitted under subsection (1) or subsection (2) may be undertaken only by a licensed driver or a minor who is under the supervision of a licensed driver. The operator must provide proof of ownership under chapter 317 upon request by a law enforcement officer. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. SENATE SUMMARY Authorizes a local government to limit the use of all-terrain vehicles to designated unpaved roadways under certain conditions.
