A limited prescription drug veterinary wholesaler that 61 4. 62 applies to the department for a new permit or the renewal of a permit must submit a bond of \$20,000, or other equivalent means 63 of security acceptable to the department, such as an irrevocable 64 letter of credit or a deposit in a trust account or financial 65 institution, payable to the Florida Drug, Device, and Cosmetic 66 Trust Fund. The purpose of the bond is to secure payment of any 67 administrative penalties imposed by the department and any fees 68 69 and costs incurred by the department regarding that permit which are authorized under state law and which the permittee fails to 70 pay 30 days after the fine or costs become final. 73 after the permittee's license ceases to be valid or until 60 74 days after any administrative or legal proceeding authorized in 75 ss. 499.001-499.081 which involves the permittee is concluded, 76 including any appeal, whichever occurs later.

5. A limited prescription drug veterinary wholesaler must maintain at all times a license or permit to engage in the wholesale distribution of prescription drugs in compliance with laws of the state in which it is a resident.

6. A limited prescription drug veterinary wholesaler must comply with the requirements for wholesale distributors under s. 499.0121, except that a limited prescription drug veterinary wholesaler is not required to provide a pedigree paper as required by s. 499.0121(6)(f) upon the wholesale distribution of a prescription drug to a veterinarian <u>or to the owner of a</u> <u>veterinary establishment permitted pursuant to s. 474.215</u>.

7. A limited prescription drug veterinary wholesaler may not return to inventory for subsequent wholesale distribution any prescription drug subject to, defined by, or described by s. 503(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act which has been returned by a veterinarian <u>or by the owner of a veterinary</u> establishment permitted pursuant to s. 474.215.
