Limitation on increases in the county's 11 operating budget.--Except as provided herein, annual increases 12 in Indian River County's operating budget shall not exceed the 13 percentage increase in the county's population, as determined by 14 the University of Florida Bureau of Economic and Business 15 16 Research's latest Florida Estimates of Population, plus the 17 percentage change in the Consumer Price Index as provided in section 193.155(1)(b), Florida Statutes. This limitation in 18 19 annual increases in the county's operating budget may be 20 overcome by a finding of necessity due to emergency or critical 21 need approved by a super majority vote of the county commission. 22 Section 2. Referendum. --In conjunction with the next countywide general 23 (1) 24 election, and in accordance with the general laws governing elections, the Supervisor of Elections of Indian River County 25 26 shall conduct a referendum of qualified electors of the county for the purpose of posing the following question: 27 28
